Since the early twentieth century artists have used paper not only as a surface to draw, paint or print on, but also as a material to compose, build and sculpt with. Tracing developments in the use of paper from the surrealist compositions of Roland Penrose to the work of present day practitioners such as John Stezaker, *On Paper* includes collages, drawings, objects and installations.

Among these varied artworks – produced on graph paper, headed paper, blotting paper, corrugated card, old envelopes or ordnance survey maps – are items that have been burnt, torn, cut, rubbed, folded or embossed.

Some artists have made paper their subject, making detailed drawings of theatre tickets, books and cards. With an informative and enjoyable essay by paper expert Ian Sansom, *On Paper* provides an illuminating overview of artists’ creative applications of this common material.
